seabirds and other native species.

**Bajo Nuevo Bank**, Primarily a maritime feature used by fishermen and for potential resources

though largely uninhabited and underdeveloped.

**Howland Island**, Uninhabited part of the Pacific Remote Islands Marine National Monument

used for wildlife conservation.

**Jarvis Island**, Primarily a wildlife refuge known for its bird populations and part of the Pacific

Remote Islands Marine National Monument.

**Johnston Atoll**, Previously utilized for nuclear testing and military operations it is now mostly

uninhabited and serves as a wildlife refuge.

**Kingman Reef**, Uninhabited and primarily a wildlife refuge it serves to protect marine life and

ecosystems.

**Midway Atoll**, Known for its historical significance in World War II it is now largely a wildlife

refuge and a site for conservation efforts, particularly for seabird populations.

**Navassa Island**, Uninhabited it is managed as a wildlife refuge with limited access primarily on

conservation.

**Northern Mariana Islands**, A bustling territory known for tourism agriculture and fishing. A

cultural melting pot focusing on sustainability.

**Palmyra Atoll**, Protected as a wildlife refuge and part of a national monument focusing on

ecological research and conservation.

**Puerto Rico**, A culturally rich territory with a diverse economy including tourism manufacturing agriculture and pharmaceuticals.

**Serranilla Bank**, Primarily a maritime feature for fishing and potential resource exploration but uninhabited.

**Virgin Islands**, Known for tourism financial services and vibrant culture with significant economic contributions from visitors.

**Wake Island**, Historically significant for military operations it now has limited civilian use and is also a site for environmental research.
